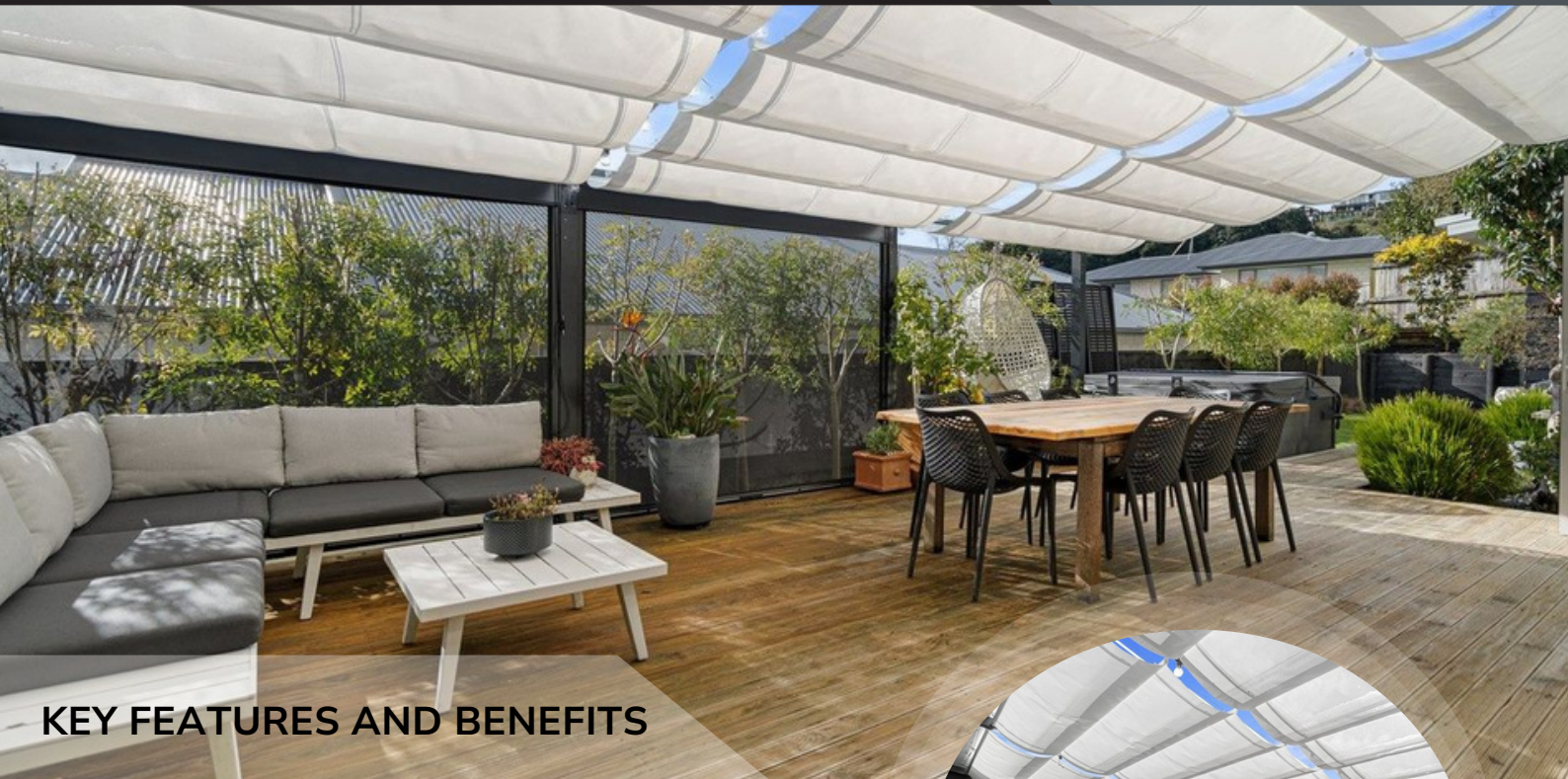

RETRACTION OPTIONS

Pole Retraction: An aluminium pole hooks to a stainless steel cleat on the front spar of the Wave Shade to manually extend & retract.

Cord & Pulley Retraction: Operates like a blind with a stainless steel pulley and lack polyester braid. This system allows you to lock the shade halfway.

FABRIC

We offer fabric options that have high levels of UPF/UVR/Shade to protect you from harmful rays with a 10-year UV warranty. Soltis 96 offers 4% openness for air flow and reducing heat. A fabric that drapes well and contains solar protection coating which extends the fabric's life.

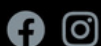
MAINTENANCE

We recommend cleaning your wave shade components with diluted house hold detergent and a soft bristled brush, rinsing with water when finished. Always ensure the fabric is dry completely before storing it. Ensure it is retracted when winds exceed 32kph. A storm strap can be used to secure your wave shade during a storm or alternatively simply remove and store it.
